GETTING TO WAG!

The Darby Bend Lakes Area of Prairie Oaks Metro Park is located at 2755 Amity Road, Hilliard, Ohio 43026. From I-270, take I-70 West to the West Jefferson/Plain City exit (exit 85). Turn right onto Plain City-Georgesville Road/State Route 142. Go about 2.25 miles (passing the main park entrance) to Lucas Road and turn right. Go across Big Darby Creek and turn right at the stop sign onto Amity Road. The entrance is about 0.5 miles on the right.

YOUR BOOTH LOCATION

Upon arrival to the park, please check-in with the WAG! Fest attendant who will be positioned on the park's entry drive. You will receive your booth assignment and be directed to its location.

MOVE-IN

You may set up your booth **beginning at 7:30 a.m.** on the day of the event. Vehicle traffic (for delivery of equipment to your booth) on the event site's paths is permissible, but only until 9:30 a.m. **Please note that all vehicles must be removed from the paths by 9:30 a.m.** After this time, materials can only be delivered to your booth by hand or by cart. As guests are likely to arrive early, please plan to have your exhibit completely set-up by no later than 9:45 a.m.

MOVE-OUT

For the benefit of our guests, **all booths must remain in place until the event closes at 4:00 p.m.** The dismantling of exhibit materials and move-out can begin upon the conclusion of the event. Once the site is clear of human and canine guests (at approximately 4:15 p.m.), you'll be able to drive to your booth to pick up equipment.

IMPORTANT BOOTH INFORMATION

Please note:

- All booth spaces measure 10' x 10'.
- **All participants must provide their own tables, chairs and canopy tent(s) unless advance rental arrangements have been made.**
- The natural setting at Prairie Oaks does not allow for electric service to booths. Quiet generators are permitted.

PARKING

Parking is free. For your convenience, a participant parking area in close proximity to the exhibit areas has been reserved for your use. **A "Participant Parking Permit" will be given to you upon check-in.** To gain access to the parking area, this pass must be displayed on your vehicle's dashboard. Park Rangers will not allow admittance to this area without display of the parking permit.
